

To make a book, first you need to create two PDFs:

- **Interior PDF** – a single-page PDF containing the finished pages of your book
- **Cover PDF** – a single-spread PDF containing the back cover, spine, and front cover

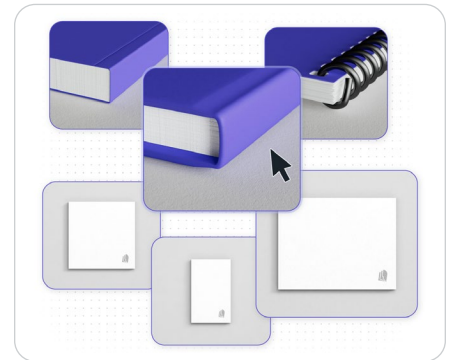
1. Choose Your Book Specifications

Your book specifications determine the dimensions of both your interior and cover files.

Select:

- Trim size (book dimensions)
- Binding type (cover style)
- Interior color (Black & White, Standard Color, or Premium Color)
- Paper type (color and weight)

Important Note: Your final page count determines the spine width for paperback and hardcover books.

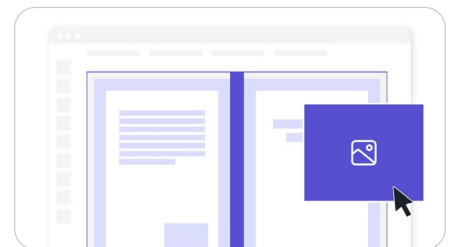

2. Prepare Your Content

For best print results:

- Use high-resolution images (300–600 PPI)
- Ensure images are sized to extend through bleed or wrap areas on design layouts
- Use RGB (sRGB) or CMYK (Coated GRACoL 2006) throughout your project
- Use grayscale images for Black & White books
- Keep image and document color spaces consistent
- For photo books or heavy ink coverage, use Premium Color with 80# White Uncoated paper

3. Create Print-Ready Files

Interior PDF

Your interior should be exported as a:

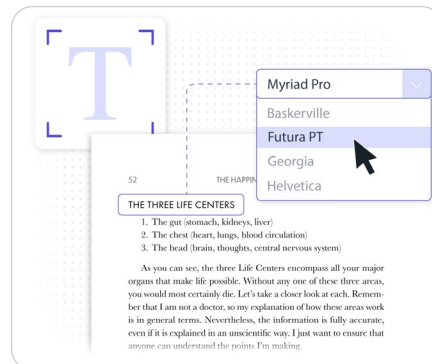
- Single-page PDF
- High-quality print PDF
- File with embedded fonts

Include:

- 0.125" bleed for full-page artwork
- Safe margins for text and important content
- Body text: 0.5" from trim edge
- Headers/footers: 0.25" from trim edge

Before exporting:

- Embed or outline all fonts
- Flatten transparency effects



Cover PDF

Your cover should be exported as a:

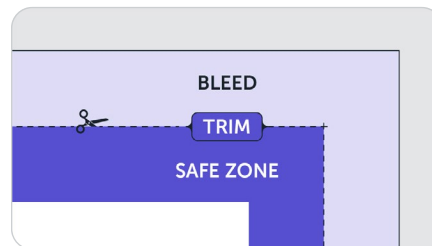
- Single-page integrated spread PDF
- Back cover + spine + front cover

Include:

- [Bleed or wrap areas](#) extending beyond trim or fold lines
- Images and backgrounds extended through bleed or wrap areas
- [Correct spine width](#) based on binding type and page count

Before exporting:

- Embed or outline all fonts
- Flatten transparency effects

Preparing Print-Ready Files

Binding-Specific Notes

Coil & Saddle Stitch

- No spine required
- Cover dimensions are based on trim size

Paperback

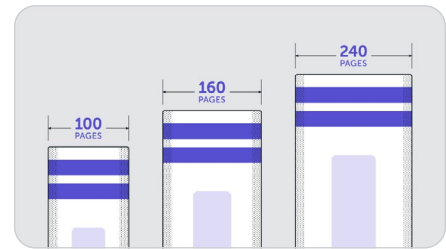
- Spine width is calculated based on page count

Hardcover Casewrap

- Spine width is based on predefined page-count ranges

Linen Wrap with Dust Jacket

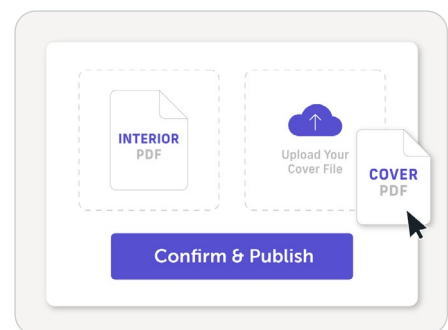
- Linen cover includes spine foil stamping
- Dust jacket includes front flap and back flap areas
- Spine width is determined by page-count ranges



4. Create Your Project

To upload your PDF files for publication and print on Lulu.com:

1. [Create a free Lulu account](#)
2. Create a project
3. Upload your interior PDF
4. Upload your cover PDF
5. Address any file warnings or errors before proceeding
6. Inspect the rendered book preview



The preview allows you to verify page layout, cover alignment, bleed, and overall appearance before publishing your project.
