

HOW TO MAKE YOUR BOOK


You may create one story per kit. Use the cover, story and illustration pages included in your kit to create your book and follow the instructions below. Your finished book will be up to 18 pages plus a front and back cover. We have included a few extra design pages in your kit for practice or corrections. Replacement pages and answers to frequently asked questions are available at lulujr.com.

ADDITIONAL COPIES

Your book is a wonderful keepsake and makes an ideal personalized gift, especially for family members, classmates and friends. To order additional copies of your book, go to lulujr.com and enter the Book ID code provided on the back cover of the finished book. You can share the Book ID code with friends and family, and they can order additional copies as well.


INTERIOR AND COVER PAGE CREATION

Design Sheet: **Story Page**




A rectangular design sheet for a story page. It features a large empty rectangular box at the top for drawing, and five horizontal lines below it for writing text.

Use story and illustration pages to create up to 18 interior pages total. Please keep your art within the box and keep text on the provided lines.

Use the page with a thick border to create 1 book cover page. Write "Cover" in pencil on back of page.



ABOUT THE AUTHOR PHOTO

Each book includes an About the Author section on the back cover. You may include a photo to accompany the About the Author text. For best results, include a vertical (portrait) oriented photo.

Write your last name (as it appears on your order form) on the back of a 2 in (width) x 3 in (height) photo and include it with your book materials when you mail them to us. Please do not paperclip or tape the photo to the page. Your photo and original pages will not be returned with your finished book.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

We highly recommend you make electronic copies of your work before mailing your completed materials, in case your delivery is lost or damaged in the mail.

Page Numbers: Your book may include up to 18 template pages. Please write the page number in pencil on the back of each template page. If there are no page numbers, your book will be printed in the order in which the pages are received.

Spelling: We do not correct spelling or provide editing services. Any text entered into your Order Form is printed exactly as you provide it (including Capitalization). Please make sure the writing is legible.

Best Results: If you use pencil to write text, trace it with a pen or marker. Please do not use pencil for illustrations or shading. For best color, use the markers included in your kit. Do not use glue, tape, or crayons.

Mailing Your Story: Complete the order form and return your completed cover and story pages using the postage-paid envelope included in your kit.

Postage Envelope: The postage paid envelope included in your kit may be used only in the United States.

Printing: Books are printed in approximately three weeks from the date received. Please allow more time during holidays and end of school terms.

Shipping: Printed books can only be shipped within the U.S. After printing, books are delivered in approximately 5-7 business days. Delivery times may vary depending on the season and location.
